# NEED TO KNOW

## DESIGN

- LEAF was recently enhanced with a refreshed exterior design, including a restyled front grille, bumper molding, and headlights.
- Roomy cabin comfortably accommodates five people, with up to 30 cubic feet of available cargo space<sup>4</sup> and a convenient 60/40 split fold-down rear seat for added flexibility.
- LEAF SV PLUS includes 17-inch alloy wheels, LED headlights, fog lights and a leather-wrapped steering wheel.

## PERFORMANCE

- EPA-estimated battery range of up to 149 miles<sup>1</sup> (LEAF S with 40-kWh battery) or up to 212 miles (LEAF SV PLUS with 60-kWh battery).
- Using the Quick Charge Port, LEAF S can be charged up to 80% in 40 minutes; LEAF SV PLUS can be charged up to 80% in 60 minutes.
- Every LEAF has the reassurance of a limited lithium-ion battery warranty covering defects in materials or workmanship for eight years or 100,000 miles.<sup>5</sup>

## TECH

- Standard NissanConnect<sup>®</sup> infotainment with an 8-inch display includes Apple CarPlay<sup>®</sup>, Android Auto<sup>™</sup>, SiriusXM<sup>®</sup> and four USB ports; LEAF SV PLUS adds Nissan Door-to-Door Navigation.
- EV-specific infotainment system functions include a charging timer, allowing the driver to set their desired charging schedule for the vehicle, and an HVAC timer, allowing for pre-heating or pre-cooling the cabin.
- LEAF SV PLUS adds heated front seats, a heated steering wheel and a hybrid heater that helps provide additional cabin warming capability.

## SAFETY AND ASSISTANCE

- Every LEAF comes standard with Nissan Safety Shield<sup>®</sup> 360<sup>6</sup>, including Automatic Emergency Braking with Pedestrian Detection, Blind Spot Warning and lane departure warning.
- LEAF SV PLUS provides added driver assistance with ProPILOT Assist<sup>7</sup>, which combines Intelligent Cruise Control<sup>®</sup> with hands-on steering assistance, and Intelligent Around View<sup>®</sup> Monitor<sup>9</sup>.
