Description of the Defect: During the traction motor assembly process, O-rings inside the motor may

have been damaged on certain Ariya vehicles. If the O-rings are damaged, it can lead to an oil leak within the motor, causing abnormal wear and debris. Over time, the debris and oil may combine, forming a mixture that can

accumulate between the brush terminal and the motor housing.

The build-up of this mixture has a risk of generating an abnormal electrical current flow within the Electric Vehicle (EV) traction motor. Subsequently, the

abnormal condition may cause the vehicle to activate "fail-safe" mode, potentially resulting in loss of motive power without warning, and no ability to

restart.
